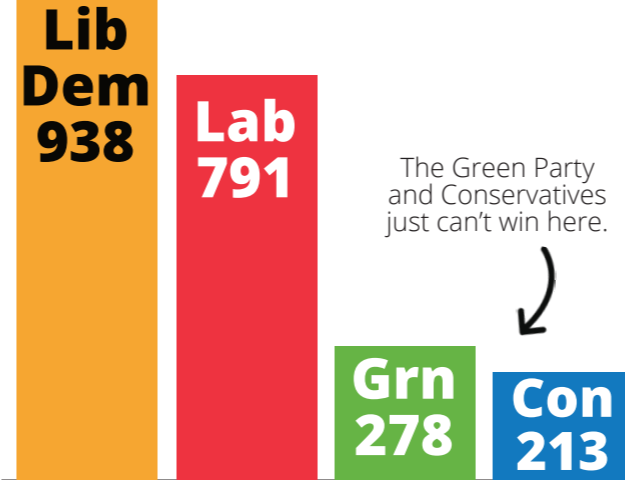

We would expand the food waste collection to the whole city and introduce a household glass recycling service. Our fully costed plans also revitalise our parks and properly fund street cleansing. Lib Dems prioritise front-line services to ensure our streets are safe and clean.

✓ A BALANCED COMMUNITY

Lib Dems have long campaigned about the number of student residences leading to community imbalance. We are pushing for more parts of the ward to have the ability to reject family homes being turned into houses of multiple occupancy. 1. Campaigning for Community Balance



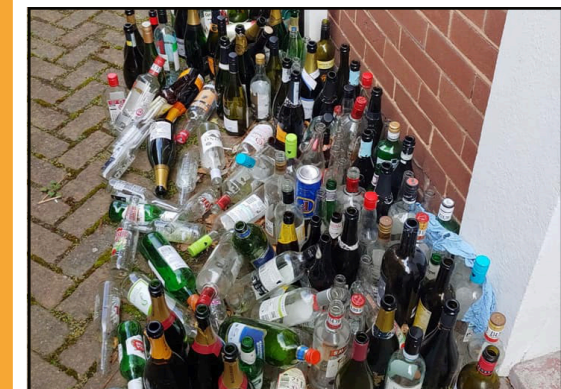

2. Make Wrefords Lane Safe Now
