Michael raised residents' concerns about potential drug use with the police and University.


Elmbridge Gardens/ Dunvegan Close/Hillcrest Park:

Hoopern Valley: Michael met with the University to discuss their proposal and how they intended to involve local residents.


New North Road:

business rates and that the Government should fully refund councils' income lost through Council Tax exemptions, discounts and support schemes - this amounts to nearly £30 million a year in Exeter.

It took two years of campaigning by Michael and Kevin to get the Council to change their mind and employ a full-time Planning Enforcement Officer to hold developers to account. Michael also got the Council to make public when they were taking action against developers.

Please use your vote for Lib Dem Michael Mitchell on Thursday 4th May to keep your strong local campaigning voice.


